### {YOU WILL NEED}

- PDF reader or Adobe Acrobat (a free download at [adobe.com](http://adobe.com)) to open this file.
- scissors, exacto knife or paper cutter
- Full sheet label paper
- printer or printing service

### {PRINTING}

- We recommend using a professional printing service for the water bottle labels. If you're using an ink jet printer and the label gets wet, everything will smear.
- If you are printing from a ink jet printer, we recommend using waterproof paper .
- If you have a laser printer and are printing from home, we recommend using full page label paper. Many office supply and craft stores offer these products.

### {CUTTING}

- If you aren't terribly skilled at cutting straight with scissors (we say this with love because we aren't either) we recommend purchasing a small scrapbook or trimming tool to get the edges perfectly straight.

### {WATER BOTTLE LABELS}

- There are 4-6 labels per 8.5" x 11" sheet.
- Simply cut out each label along the outside border either with your scissors or paper cutter. Peel off label backing and stick on bottle. (Depending on what brand you use, these labels are very sticky and once on the bottle can not be removed).
